

**Decision on the proposal to create Additional Resourced Provision (ARP) at Comet Nursery School & Children’s Centre, Sebright Primary School, and Stoke Newington School & Sixth Form**

The proposal to establish Additional Resourced Provision (ARP) for pupils with SEND, of 24 (or 12 full-time equivalent) Early Years SEND assessment places at Comet Nursery School and Children’s Centre, 24 places for children with Speech, Language and Communication Needs (SLCN) at Sebright Primary School, and 30 places for children with Social, Emotional and Mental Health (SEMH) Needs at Stoke Newington School and Sixth Form, was agreed by Hackney Council on 20 June 2024.

The proposal forms part of the SEND strategy to provide additional high-quality SEND provision in Hackney. The proposed new Additional Resourced Provisions will open by the end of 2025 (and by the end of September 2025 in the case of Comet Nursery School and Children’s Centre).
