

Prescribed alteration to Harrington Hill Community School from September 2014

UNDERTAKEN BY HACKNEY LEARNING TRUST

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Hackney Learning Trust intends to make a prescribed alteration to Harrington Hill (Community) Primary School, Harrington Hill, London E5 9EY, from 01 September 2014.


Hackney Learning Trust proposes to permanently expand Harrington Hill from 1 form of entry (30 pupils admitted each year), to 3 forms of entry (90 pupils admitted each year), from 01 September 2014.

The current capacity of the school is 300 and the proposed capacity will be 630. The current number of pupils on roll at the school is 288, and the number of pupils in reception is 60. The current admission number for the school is 30 and the proposed admission number will be 90.

Harrington Hill School currently operates across two sites; Harrington Hill, E5 9EY and Mount Pleasant E5 9JG. The proposed expansion of the school will continue with the same split site arrangement.
