



Decision on the proposal to expand Ickburgh School to provide additional places for children with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND)

Following a period of public representation that took place from 6 November to 3 December 2025, the Council reached a final decision regarding the proposed expansion of Ickburgh School. At its meeting on 14 January 2026, the Council agreed to proceed with the expansion plans, marking a significant step forward for the school and the wider community.

This expansion forms part of Hackney's Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) strategy, ensuring we continue to provide additional high-quality SEND provision for children and young people in Hackney, so that their educational needs can be met locally and effectively. It will provide additional places for 48 children with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND), by September 2027. The new places will be located at the former Baden Powell Primary School site in Ferron Road, E5.
