# On behalf of the staff, governors and children of St John the Baptist, I would like to welcome you to our school and into our fantastic school community.

St John the Baptist is a Church of England primary school with a 2-year-old and 3-year-old Nursery. We provide an inclusive, caring and supportive environment where children learn and flourish. This is driven by our school's vision "love our neighbour as ourselves." We welcome applications for admissions from families of all faiths and none, with the expectation that all families will support the ethos of the school.

The school has a mixed admission limit of 30 and 60 places year groups from Reception to Year 6. For Nursery there are 2 rooms with 52 part time places (26 full time) in the over 3 Nursery room and 20 part time places (10 full time) in the 3 and under Nursery room. We offer a mixture of full time and part time places according to parent's needs.

As a community, we share the responsibility of ensuring that the children in our care are happy, resilient, and successful; fully prepared to meet the challenges of an ever-changing world. At our school, our ultimate goal is for all children to become independent, self-motivated, and responsible members of society. However, this can only be achieved when we all work together. The school is strongly committed to working in partnership with our families and extended communities. Good communication between home and school enables a strong partnership which is built on trust.
