

Statutory Notice to propose the creation of Additional Resource Provision for SEND at Stoke Newington School and Sixth Form

The London Borough of Hackney proposes to establish Additional Resource Provision (ARP) for SEND at Stoke Newington School and Sixth Form from the end of 2025.

The number of children and young people with an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) in Hackney has increased significantly. Children and young people identified as having Social, Emotional and Mental Health (SEMH) Needs have accounted for a significant proportion of the increase in EHCPs in Hackney.

The London Borough of Hackney (the Council) therefore proposes to establish:

- a 30-place ARP for Social, Emotional and Mental Health (SEMH) Needs at Stoke Newington School and Sixth Form.

The ARP will offer children with SEND the benefit of attending a mainstream school, whilst also receiving specialist input for their needs.

The new Additional Resource Provision will be based at the current site of Stoke Newington School and Sixth Form, Clissold Road, London N16 9EX.

Admission to the ARP will be determined by the London Borough of Hackney's Education, Health and Care Panel.
