Contract: Fixed Term until July 2026 (likely to be extended)

#### Main purpose of the job:

• To plan and provide a welcoming, caring, and engaging breakfast and tea club provision.

- To set up and deliver a range of fun, open-ended activities appropriate for both morning and afternoon sessions.
- To ensure a safe, inclusive, and nurturing environment that supports the well-being and development of all children.

#### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Provide a safe, relaxed, and homely environment for children during extended day provision.
- Deliver a high standard of physical care and emotional support.
- Prepare and serve a healthy breakfast and a cooked tea, ensuring food hygiene standards are met.
- Encourage children to try a variety of foods and support healthy eating habits.
- Establish positive relationships with children, responding to their individual needs.
- Promote positive interactions and cooperative play among children.
- Ensure equal access to all activities and resources.
- Work collaboratively and supportively as part of the Comet team.
- Uphold and implement all school policies, promoting the vision and values of Comet.
- Participate in relevant training and professional development.
