



Cardinal Pole Catholic School is a comprehensive, mixed, 11-18 oversubscribed school with exceptional facilities.

GCSE

An impressive 69% of the cohort achieved the benchmark of a Grade 4 or above in both English and Mathematics, surpassing last year's record of 64%. Fantastic results were secured in English (84% 4+), Maths (75% 4+), Science (73% 4+). Progress 8 for 2019 continues to improve and is well above national at 0.41.

A LEVEL

Building on the fantastic success of last summer's results, students at Cardinal Pole Catholic School celebrated amazing A level results. Already amongst the top 10% of schools for progress according to national A Level Progress measures (ALPs), the percentage of A*, A and B grades still increased this year, with 21% of grades at A*-A, an exceptional 61% at A*-B and 85% at A*-C.

The 2017 OFSTED praised the work of the school. Our most recent inspection in October 2016 from the Diocese of Westminster graded the school as outstanding in every category. The report commented that our 'distinctive inclusive ethos of this school is tangible in every area of school life from classroom to corridors and in relationships between students and staff' and described progress as outstanding. Importantly, it described the school as a 'safe place that allows all to flourish' and a place where 'Students make outstanding progress'.
