The school won Primary of the Year 2012. We also have an **Ofsted** Early Years and Extended Services 'outstanding' at Mapledene Children's Centre for work in the local community. Queensbridge has a longstanding relationship with UCL (was IOE) and is a Specialist Partner for Initial Teacher Training. As a designated National Teaching School (Future Stars) we hold many significant awards including ArtsMark Platinum, music, EYFS, DSR and computing. We are highly creative and love performing arts- we have strong links to performing arts locally and nationally for enrichment. We also lead the Reading Hub and work with DFE to help outside London with Recruitment and Retention in Norwich and Suffolk as a Teaching school.
