We are an outstanding 11-19 academy. We prioritise high quality learning and teaching to ensure successful student achievement. Our students are keen to learn and a pleasure to teach. On the AQA Thematic paper 2 we study Relationships and Family, Religion and Life, Crime and Punishment and Human Rights and Social Justice. This enables us to dive deeper into beliefs and values that were introduced at KS3. In KS5 OCR Religious Studies, the students study Philosophy, Ethics and Buddhism.
